

Additional Charges

These charges would be **added** to the basic prices listed elsewhere in this brochure if needed or desired.

- 1) **Oversewing** \$ 25
This would be necessary if the book had become loose in its sewing **ONLY** at the very front and/or the very back of the book. The remainder of the text block must still be tight in its sewing.
- 2) **Convert “perfect” binding** \$ 30 & up
“Perfect” bindings are not sewn but a glob of hot glue is put on the spine edge of the single sheets of the book. Rarely do these bindings last very long. We convert these bindings to a reinforced double fan binding which is far superior.
- 3) **To Completely Re-Sew the book** \$ 30 & up
This would be necessary if the whole book had become loose in its sewing, or the sewing threads had become broken.
- 4) **Repair Tears** \$ 15 & up
This would attempt to repair major tears in the book.
- 5) **Book Cleaning** \$ 10 & up
- 6) **Additional Ribbon Markers** (each) \$ 2
The number may be limited by the size of the book.
- 7) **Raised Bands on Spine** \$ 15
Only available on leather bindings.
- 8) **Additional Imprinting** (per line) \$ 10
This applies to things like your name on the front cover (bottom right corner), title on the front, other lines of text.
- 9) **Decorative Endpapers** \$ 10 & up
Such as marbled papers. Choices may be limited.
- 10) **Shipping & Sales Taxes** would also be added as applicable.

Bible Rebinding

All Bibles come with new endsheets, headbands, a satin ribbon marker, a new cover and up to three lines of gold stamping. Optional features and extra repair work are done for the additional charges described on the back of this brochure. **NOTE:** Since bonded or imitation leather will not last as long we only use genuine leather in rebinding Bibles.

Large Family Bibles

The actual price depends upon the size of the Bible and the amount and nature of the repair work to be done. The minimum charge for work on one of these Bibles is \$125.

Book Rebinding

Books to be rebound would have new endsheets, headbands, a new cover and the Title and Author stamped in gold on the spine of the book. Some mending would also be included. Optional features and extra repair work are done for the additional charges described elsewhere in this brochure.

Book Restoration

Restoration work on old or valuable books is also available. Methods appropriate to the period are used to restore the book back to its original condition. Pricing is determined by the nature of the work to be done.

Re-Casing

If your book or Bible has merely become loose from its cover, the text block can be redone with new endsheets, headbands and a ribbon marker (for Bibles) and the old cover reattached. This will add years of usefulness to your present binding. To be able to do this the text block itself must be in good condition. The charge for this service would be \$ 30 to \$50, depending upon size.

New Binding

We can also bind magazines, church bulletins, college thesis or dissertations, just about any group of documents can be bound together into a book. Let us know of your needs.

Please remove photos, clippings, etc... and correct all dog-eared pages before sending book for repair.

*Measuring Information:

To determine which size category your book would fall into, measure the front cover.

Small = Up to 7" x 5"

Average = Up to 10" x 8"

Large = Larger than 10" x 8"
